## Global Art Project For Peace Guidelines for Participating Artists

1. During the week of April 23–30 send your art to your GAP partner. This is a gift that you're giving to another person or group; it will not be returned. It would be nice to include a personal note and a photo of yourself or our group. If you cannot send your art during that week, let your partner know that you cannot send your art at that time. For those sending art out of your own country, do not insure your package, indicate \$0 or a small amount as the value of the package and indicate that it is a gift...this will ensure that the person receiving it will not have to pay exorbitant customs fees to receive your package. Don't send seeds or other living materials outside your country.

## 2. After you receive the art, send a thank-you note to your partner to confirm that their work arrived.

3. If you don't receive an artwork, contact your partner. You've been given all the information that your partner gave us. Give your partner the benefit of the doubt. International mail can take a very long time. And remember: participating in the Project involves risk — human nature is unpredictable. It's important not to focus on what you will receive; but rather, to have an attitude of unconditional giving and a knowing that you've added your vision to the collective energy for peace.

## 4. Angel Corps: If you haven't heard from your partner by the end of June and you've tried to make contact, let us know and we'll connect you with someone in the Angel Corps to send you art. *If you'd like to create art for the Angel Corps, please let us know!*

5. **GAP ArtBank:** If possible, email us photos and/or videos of the art you or your group create for the exchange to possibly be included in the 2024 Gallery on the Project website. It would be great to include photos of your group creating their art and information about your experiences with creating the art and participating in the Project. Your images and words can continue to inspire others. Also send us a copy of posters from GAP exhibitions and any news articles about GAP activities in your area that appear in your local publications. Please fill out and send us the *Donation of Copyright* form along with your photos and/or videos.

6. **Volunteer Form:** If you'd like to be a Regional Coordinator or volunteer in other ways to help the Global Art Project, let us know. Check off what you would like to do on the Volunteer Form. We'll contact you with additional information about what you can do to get involved. *We'd love to have your help*!
